**2022 Nominations for the Thames Valley District School Board, the London District Catholic School Board and Conseil scolaire catholique Providence**

Pursuant to the provisions of Ontario Regulation 412/00, section 11 (3), the City of Woodstock will be responsible for receiving nominations for persons to be elected as school board members for the following school boards:

- Thames Valley District School Board – two (2) positions available;
- The London District Catholic School Board – one (1) position available; and
- The Conseil scolaire catholique Providence – one (1) position available for the counties of Oxford, Elgin, and Middlesex.

Pursuant to subsection 11 (3), potential school board trustee candidates will need to file their nominations with the Clerk of the City of Woodstock and within 48 hours after the closing of nominations the Clerk will send by registered mail the names of the candidates to appear on the ballot.

Please be advised that subsection 11 (5) states that each municipal Clerk is responsible for their own election within their geographic area and must promptly report the school board vote of their election to the Clerk of the City of Woodstock. Upon receiving the votes, the Clerk of the City of Woodstock will prepare the final summary and announce the result of the vote.

The City of Woodstock will be placing the necessary election advertisements in the City's local publications. Your municipality is responsible for placing and paying for advertisements in your municipality.
